
I am very pleased to inform you of the exceptional achievement of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant of Lusby, Maryland, in the field of occupational safety and health. The considerable effort by the entire workforce was evident during a rigorous review that the Maryland Occupational Safety and Health (MOSH) program recently conducted. Consequently, I have approved them for our Voluntary Protection Programs (VPP) at the Star level. This is the ninth Maryland employer to be named a MOSH VPP Star site.

Since 1982, The Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration has been recognizing American worksites that have exemplary records and demonstrate commitment to workplace safety and health. Fewer than 2,000 worksites, of the nearly 8 million in the United States, currently share this honor. Sites meeting VPP 's demanding requirements typically experience injury and illness rates more than 50% percent below their industry average.

VPP sites are positive corporate citizens and excellent neighbors. They become models for what employers and employees can achieve by working cooperatively with one another and with MOSH to achieve a level of worker protection that goes beyond compliance with government regulations. VPP participants mentor other businesses and promote safety and health within their communities.

MOSH is pleased to work with and recognize the men and women of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant for their commitment to workplace safety, and I appreciate the opportunity to let you know of their achievements in this area.
